NECIS Softball Tournament Tie Break Procedure

In the event of a **TWO-TEAM TIE at the end of the group stage** the following steps are to be done (in order) to determine which team advances to the next stage of the competition:

- 1) Result of the **mutual** game.
- 2) If mutual game is tied, the individual tie break will come into operation.

Starting with top of the extra inning and each half-inning thereafter, the offensive team shall begin its turn at bat with the player who batted last in the previous inning placed at 2nd base (in scoring position). The player who is running can be substituted in accordance with substitution rules.

In the event of a **THREE-TEAM TIE at the end of the group stage** the following steps are to be followed (in order) to determine which team advances to the next stage of the competition:

- 1) Runs scored minus runs conceded from the mutual games involving the 3 teams
- 2) Least runs allowed from the mutual games (2017 rule change)
- 3) Run Difference: runs scored minus runs conceded from all group games

In the event of a **TWO-TEAM TIE** in the playoff stage the individual tie break will come into play:

Starting with top of the extra inning and each half-inning thereafter, the offensive team shall begin its turn at bat with the player who batted last in the previous inning placed at 2nd base (in scoring position). The player who is running can be substituted in accordance with substitution rules.

At all age levels, a maximum of +10 runs per game will count towards a team's run difference.
